1.	Is the title a misspelling?; deadly; Morgan Freeman, the veteran + Brad Pitt, the rookie; Brad Pitt earned \$X million for this film (X is the title of the film!); sinful.	
2.	Amarcord, Satyricon; amazingly 2 Fs, 2 As, 2 Cs and 2Ms; Vuit I mig (in Catalan); "Remember, this is a comedy."; Ginger Rogers & Fred Astaire?	
3.	Set in Johannesburg, South Africa; shown at the Phoenix 2011, 76% audience vote; sci-fi; the title is a nod to a real place and a real incident - in a mixed race area of Cape Town demolished by the apartheid government in 1966 to make room for whites; appropriate for today, maybe.	
4.	British serial killer, John Christie; Richard Attenborough; set in 1949, released in 1971; the street of the title is in the Notting Hill area of London.	
5.	With a theme tune called <i>College Boy</i> ; Bamber or Jeremy?; picture or music?; use your brains for this one.	
6.	Henry Fonda; guilty or not guilty?; Sydney Lumet directed; none of the actors playing the jurors are still alive.	
7.	Won 3 out of 9 Oscar nominations, including the first film from a black director to win Best Picture award; Chiwetel Ejiofor; Steve McQueen; the Thirteenth Amendment.	
8.	Houston, we have a ...; Tom Hanks, Ed Harris; to the Moon via Saturn.	
9.	John Carpenter directed the 1976 original; Ethan Hawke and Laurence Fishburne star in the 2005 remake; the action is far from pedestrian; unlucky for some of the characters; the original is considered a cult classic.	

10.	William Holden won the Oscar for Best Actor for his performance; b & w war film; directed by Billy Wilder; Betty Grable; the black queen in a chess set.	
11.	Yossarian; Joseph Heller's novel; Mike Nichols direction; Barışa giden yol, the film's title in Turkish is no help, but avoids the number!; "In order to be grounded, I've got to be crazy. And I must be crazy to keep flying."	
12.	A Christmas classic; made first in 1947, remade in 1994; Kris Kringle (aka Santa Claus) was Edmund Gwenn or Richard Attenborough; Macy's Department store (the setting of the 1947 film), is on the titular NY street.	
13.	Robert Donat; The Forth Bridge; from London to north of the border with a British pop-dance group?; John Buchan; directed by the master of suspense.	
14.	A 1950 western; directed by Anthony Mann; a city 12 miles from this cinema; James Stewart; not a mullet hairstyle or platform boots in sight!	
15.	Anne Bancroft, Anthony Hopkins, Judi Dench; mail order second-hand books; convenient for trains to South-east London and Kent; the German title of the film translates as "Between the Lines".	
16.	Canine revenge; spot the 1961 animation; Glenn Close at her cruellæst!; popular in Dubrovnik cinemas.	
17.	Ajoutez cent; Cairo; Jean Dujardin; the Phoenix Christmas film in 2012, 74% audience vote; The Pride of French Intelligence?; the same team was "Lost in Rio" in 2009.	
18.	Aron Ralston's true story; Danny Boyle; the Horseshoe Canyon, Utah; James Franco plays the lead role.	
19.	A Ray Bradbury novel; Julie Christie; hot, hot, hot (the title, not Julie Christie!); François Truffaut; spoken credits.	
20.	Kubrick; H.A.L.; released 33 years ahead of its time; a working title was <i>How the Solar System Was Won</i> .
